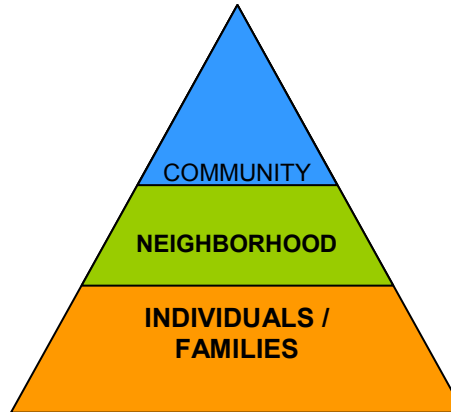


NEIGHBOR HELPING NEIGHBOR
