



## Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) Training

The City of Issaquah, in partnership with Issaquah Citizen Corps and Eastside Fire and Rescue is offering a Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) Program which educates people about disaster preparedness for hazards that may impact their area and trains them in basic disaster response skills, such as fire safety, light search and rescue, team organization, and disaster medical operations. Using the training learned in the classroom and during exercises, CERT members can assist others in their neighborhood or workplace following an event when professional responders are not immediately available to help. The CERT program consists of eight class sessions, three hours each.
